Nandina Domestica 'AKA'



- Red new growth foliage most of the year
- 20% more compact than Nandina domestica Nana and Gulfstream

Blush is the only medium dwarf Nandina that gets red new growth most of the year. While most Nandinas are shooting new green growth in spring, summer and autumn, Blush is shooting loads of red new growth. With a spread of 60cm and a mature height of 60cm to 70cm, it is

a perfect height for use along fences and borders, and can be made into a beautiful hedge. As Nandina domestica Nana and Gulf Stream get taller, growing to 90cm, they are more work to keep into a tidy hedge. These heights are based on research data, and observations of mature plants.

Blush's winter colour is amazing.

Blush has the most vivid red winter growth of all Nandina. In most Australian winters, Blush will turn red all over. In warmer climates like mid to northern Queensland, the colour will not be quite as red. Blush turns red in winter similar to Nandina Domestica Nana, just a little more vivid. Blush is very drought, cold and humidity tolerant, growing well all over Australia. Research shows this variety is a safe choice around bushland, as it will not spread from seed.
