Nandina Domestica 'MURASAKI' 

- Red new growth foliage most of the year
- Dwarf ground cover Nandina

Flirt is the only dwarf ground cover Nandina that will give you red new growth in spring, autumn, and often in summer. It still gets the extra red tones in winter like the other dwarf Nandina. Flirt was bred from Harbour Dwarf, and retains its low growing and spreading characteristics, but with the added bonus of masses of red new growth. The only reason Harbour Dwarf is not as popular, is that it is mainly green. Flirt is the perfect red toned ground cover,

spreading 40cm to 50cm in diameter. People often use Nandina thinking they will only grow to 40cm, when the medium size Nandina Domestica Nana, and Gulf Stream will grow from 70cm to 80cm or more. This plant is very drought, cold and humidity tolerant, growing well all over Australia. Research shows this variety is a safe choice around bushland, as it will not spread from seed.

DESCRIPTION Red flushing ground cover  
 HEIGHT & WIDTH 30-40 cm x 20-40 cm  
 POSITION Full sun or shade  
 CARE Prune every few years if desired  
 USES Groundcover, low hedge, feature  
 SOIL TYPE Free draining to heavy clay soils
