Naringa is the best hedging form of Westringia.

- Tidier form
- Much less pruning
- Lots of mauve coloured flowers in spring



A tidy look without the work

Westringia is known to be one of the tough Australian native shrubs. It is widely used and performs well in the landscape. However to keep it at its best it needs pruning every one to two years. Naringa needs pruning at least half as much as other Westringias, and in a natural setting probably not at all. Naringa gives you a tidy look without the work. It flowers profusely in spring, and regularly at other times. Naringa grows to 2 metres high (1 metre with pruning) with a 500mm to 1 metre spread.

Naringa in the middle is far more tidy than the normal Westringia.



SHRUBS & GROUND COVERS

DESCRIPTION	The best hedging form of Westringia
HEIGHT & WIDTH	Up to 2m x 0.5-1m spread
POSITION	Full sun to part shade
CARE	Prune to shape as required
USES	Tidy hedging or specimen plant
SOIL TYPE	Sandy to well drained clay soils
