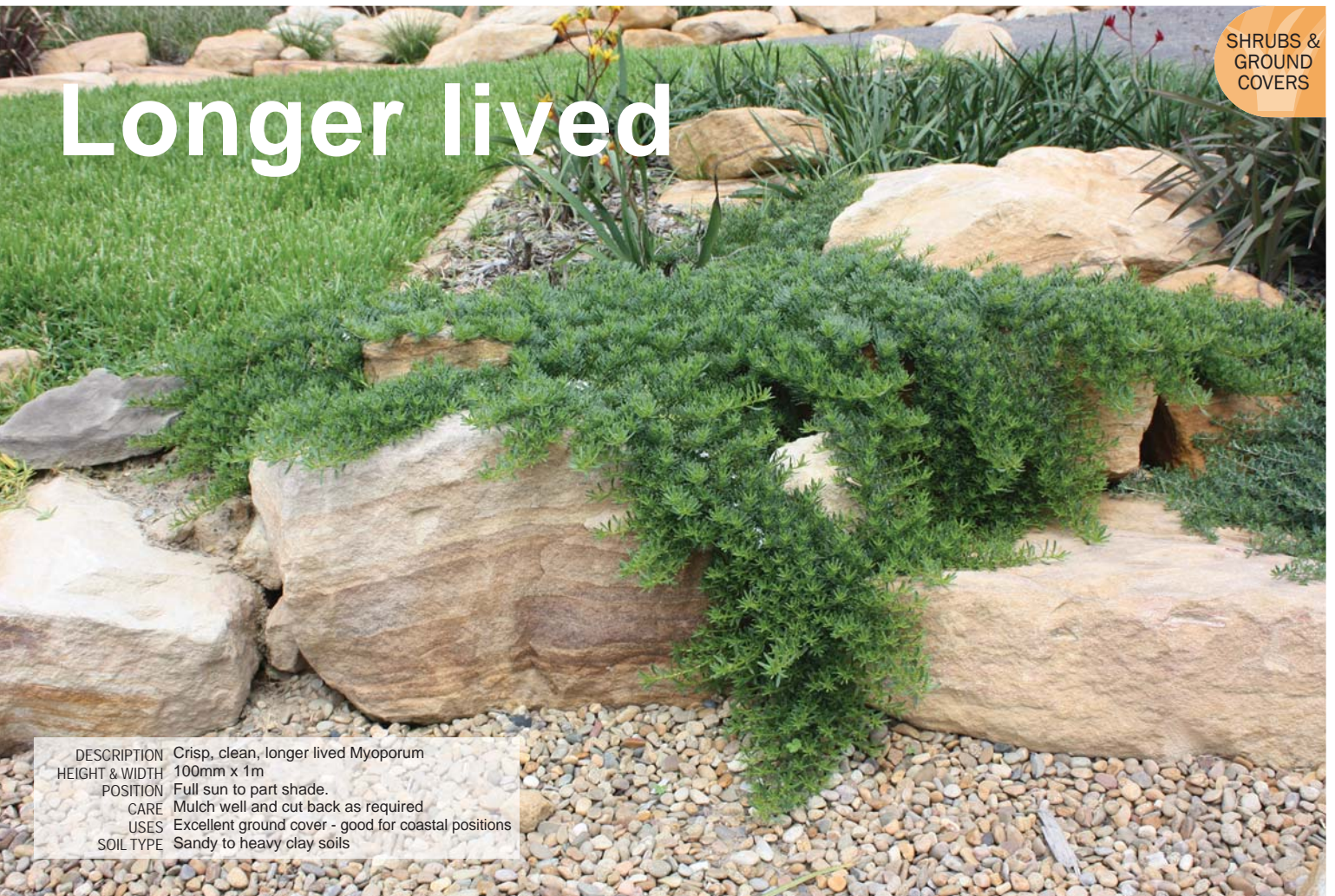
Myoporum parvifolium 'Parv01' (PBR)

The first thing you notice about this Myporum is its crisp clean foliage.

- Crisp clean foliage
- Longer lived
- Masses of white flowers



The flowers on Yareena are as good as most forms. Its tough frost resistant foliage makes this plant stand out. It is very drought tolerant and tolerates a wide array of soil types and climates. Myoporum parvifolium is probably the best Australian native ground cover, but recently too many shorter lived varieties are being sold. It needs planting at 4 to 6 plants per square metre. Yareena is not a fine leaf form, but a typical leaf type, which also helps it live longer. Fine leaf forms are generally short lived. Yareena's thick woody stems is why it survives so well, but its beautiful clean foliage covers these so you do not see them. Play it safer, use Yareena, the longer lived Myoporum parvifolium.



DESCRIPTION	Crisp, clean, longer lived Myoporum
HEIGHT & WIDTH	100mm x 1m
POSITION	Full sun to part shade.
CARE	Mulch well and cut back as required
USES	Excellent ground cover - good for coastal positions
SOIL TYPE	Sandy to heavy clay soils
